IMPORTANT DETAILS

- **Dress Code:** Current school uniform or nice shorts/pants with a polo shirt. (No piercings, hats, beanies or backpacks are allowed for the day.)

COVID-19 PROTOCOL

Bosco is taking every precaution to keep our campus safe for staff, faculty and guests. We have some safety guidelines for visitors that we would like to share with you before your scheduled visit.

Prior to entering the school:

- Visitors will have their temperature screened outside the main office before entering the school.
- Visitors who refuse to have their temperature screened or have a temperature of over 100.4 will be denied access to the school.
- All visitors will need to wear a mask, per our current COVID-19 Face Mask Policy.

WHO SHOULD SIGN UP FOR A SHADOW DAY?

We invite any current 8th-11th grade prospective student to experience the Bosco Brotherhood through our shadow program. Alongside a Bosco Student Ambassador, students will attend classes, tour our 36-acre campus, and meet faculty and current students.

MAY MY 7TH GRADER SHADOW?

Due to high demand, we reserve our Shadow Days for current 8th-11th grade prospective students. 7th graders are welcome and encouraged to join us for a Campus Tour, Middle School Night, Open House, or any other Admissions event.

CAN A STUDENT SHADOW TWICE?

IS SHADOWING MANDATORY FOR ALL PROSPECTIVE FAMILIES?

Upon clicking "submit" when you completed our online registration form, a confirmation email is sent notifying you that your registration was submitted. You will receive a reminder email approximately 24 hours before your scheduled Shadow Day.

CAN MY SON REQUEST A SPECIFIC STUDENT TO SHADOW?

We love pairing shadow students with current Bosco students they might know. However, sometimes extenuating circumstances don't allow for this to happen. When registering for a Shadow Day, please list any specific requests in the "Out of Curiosity" section at the end of the request form.

WHAT WILL MY STUDENT BE DOING ON HIS SHADOW DAY?

Your student will be paired up with a Bosco Student Ambassador with similar interests; academic classes, extra-curricular activities, etc. Alongside his Student Ambassador, he will attend classes, tour our 36-acre campus, and meet faculty and join our student body for lunch.

WHAT SHOULD MY STUDENT BRING?

Your son does not need to bring anything but themselves! A backpack is not necessary. In the event that a test or quiz is being given in a class, a book or personal device (cell phone, tablet, iPad) is sometimes helpful.

MAY MY STUDENT BRING THEIR CELL PHONE?

Cell phones are allowed on campus. However, we ask that they remain turned off or on silent during class periods.

SHOULD MY STUDENT BRING A LUNCH?
